Getting to Melrose:

Car:

82 miles from Glasgow, 38 miles from Edinburgh.

From anywhere, get to the Edinburgh city bypass, go east to Sheriffhall roundabout. Carry straight on A720 towards East Lothian. Take 1st exit for A68, Jedburgh. Carry on A 68 for 35 miles . Turn right on to A6091, Melrose bypass. Take 2nd right (signed for Melrose). As you enter town, carry straight on. Townhouse is in town square with parking outside.

Rail:

Connections from Edinburgh to Tweedbank every 30 mins at peak times.

Melrose is a 20 minute walk from station (1.8 miles)

Buses twice per hour. Suggest 7.40 train from Edinburgh arrives Tweedbank 8.40. Connects to Number 68 bus at 8.43 (Jedburgh) which takes 8 mins to get to Melrose
